



## Bobby Glynn Roberts

April 7, 1937 - September 20, 2022

Bobby Glynn Roberts, age 85, died peacefully on September 20th at The Arbors memory care facility in Lexington, TN, home to him for the last couple of years. Bobby was born and raised in Lexington, and was a graduate of Lexington High School. In his early years, Bobby worked in the U Totem grocery store. Bobby later opened his own meat processing business on Hwy 22 North in Lexington, next to his home. Bobby came to be known throughout West TN with his successful meat processing business. After many years of meat processing, Bobby came weary of the demands and long hours of running the business and chose to take a job at the Milan Arsenal, where Bobby worked for many years. After retiring from the Milan Arsenal, Bobby worked for lifelong friend Johnny Moore at Clayton Homes in Jackson, TN. Bobby was a long time member of Pine Grove Church in Lexington, where he served as a Deacon for many years and also served in the Tennessee National Guard. Bobby, along with his wife Shirley, friends and early members of the Church, helped the Church grow and were able to expand the Church facilities and grounds through several phases. Bobby is survived by his son Tim (Anna) Roberts; daughter Jennifer (Brent) Burnine; 2 grandchildren, Caylee Burnine, and Hannah (Dalton) Byrd; brother Jerry (Wanda) Roberts. He was preceded in death by his wife, Shirley Roberts; parents John and Alice Roberts; sister, Billie (Gilbert) Coffman; brothers, Joe (Betty) Roberts, Guy (Clara) Roberts.
