Clarence John Lemley was born in McIntosh, South Dakota on August 7, 1939. He attended grade school and high school in McIntosh. He participated in track and football and graduated as valedictorian in 1959.

In 1961, he married Agnes Sanders in Faulkton, South Dakota. He received his degree in Electrical Engineering from South Dakota School of Mines in 1963.

After graduation, he accepted a job with Century Electric in St. Louis, Missouri. They lived in St. Louis for 7 years. In 1970, he accepted a transfer to Lexington, Tennessee with the same company. Though the company was bought and sold many times over the years, he remained resident engineer with them until 1998.

Clarence loved gardening and grew organic vegetables that many friends and family enjoyed each season.

He leaves behind his wife of 53 years, Agnes, his three daughters: Susan Waldon (Scott) of Wake Forest, North Carolina, Laura Reed (Donnie) of Franklin, Tennessee, and Rachel Sheppard (Tony) of Louisville, Kentucky. He has nine grand children: Shawn, Chris, Jeddy and Katie Waldon; Shelby, Caleb and Jacob Reed; and Lydia and Matthew Sheppard.
