



## Dean Holbert Jr

November 16, 1947 - March 5, 2019

Dean Holbert, age, 71, of Parsons, TN, passed away suddenly Tuesday, March 5th, at Jackson-Madison Co. General Hospital after a medical procedure.

Dean was born November 16, 1947 in Pulaski, TN to the late Oakley Dean Holbert, Sr. and Annie Lou Graves Holbert.

He graduated from Campbellsville High School then Austin Peay State University. He later obtained his Masters Degree in Education from the University of Tennessee. Dean worked in the Decatur Co. School System as an Educator and Principle for a while, then he began a 33 year career with Sysco Corporation where he received numerous awards based on sales. He obtained the Touchbearer Finalist Award and then the Touchbearer Award while with Sysco. After his retirement, he worked as office manager and senior tax advisor for H & R Block in Parsons. He continued this position until his death. Dean also was a cattle farmer where he enjoyed raising Angus Cattle. He was an active member of Parsons Lions Club and Parsons First Baptist Church where he served as church organist for over 30 years. Dean had served on the Parsons City Council and served 2 terms as City of Parsons Mayor. He loved hunting, farming, sports, playing the organ and attending his grandchildren's sporting events.

He is survived by his wife, of Dana (Hopper) Holbert, of Parsons; two sons, Keenan (Christy) Holbert, of Knoxville; Kurt (Melanie) Holbert, of Decaturville; a sister, Dot Cooper, of Pulaski.

He is also survived by 4 Grandchildren - Jackson, Lainie, Trece and Tenlee Holbert.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by 2 brothers, Coleman and Doug Holbert.

His Funeral Service will be held at Parsons First Baptist Church on Friday, March 8th at 1 PM with Bro. Kevin Bromley officiating. Burial will follow in Crossroads Cemetery.

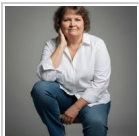
