He was also a fan of the Tennessee Vols and Lady Vols. Wayne was saved and baptized in the First Baptist Church. He loved the Jack Hay Sunday School Class where he served in various capacities over the years. Visitation will be Sunday from 2pm to

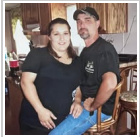
