

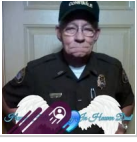


Fannie Mae Singleton

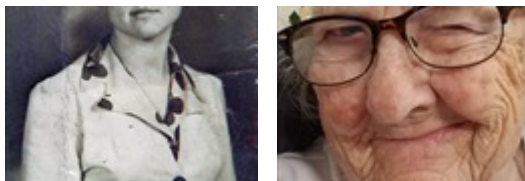
