Funeral services for Fred Fiddler, age 90, are scheduled for 11AM on Saturday, November 4 at Reed's Chapel in Lexington with interment to follow at Lexington Cemetery. He passed away on Wednesday, November 1 at Huntingdon Health and Rehabilitation Center after a lengthy illness. Fred was born October 14, 1927, to Clifford and Fairy Wood Fiddler of Wildersville. He attended Henderson County schools, graduating from Lexington High School in 1945. He served in the Army during the Korean conflict as a dental x-ray technician. He then attended Union University in Jackson, graduating in 1957 with a degree in Biology and Chemistry after which he began teaching at Lexington High School. Eventually, he earned his Masters Degree in Education from Memphis State University and continued teaching at Lexington High School until his retirement in 1986. He also was plant chemist at Lexington Metal Products, later Johnson Controls, for 30 years. He was a member of Rock Hill Baptist Church for over 50 years, where he served in several capacities. He enjoyed traveling, fishing, crafts, and other activities. He and his wife Marjorie especially enjoyed camping monthly with the West Tennessee Traveling Sams after retirement. Survivors include his wife of 69 years, Marjorie Keeton Fiddler; a daughter, Sherry Fiddler of Lexington; 3 grandsons, Daniel Fiddler, John Fiddler, and Andy (Courtney) Herda; and 4 great grandchildren, Riley Herda, Leah Herda, Ethan Fiddler, and Gideon Fiddler. In addition to his parents, he was preceded by a daughter, Linda Herda, and a granddaughter, Sara Hines. Visitation will be on Friday from

4PM-8PM and Saturday from 9AM till service.
