



## G. L. Teague

January 6, 1939 - April 21, 2016

Mr. G.L. Teague of Parsons, TN passed away on Thursday, April 21, 2016 at Decatur Co. Manor.

After graduation from Decaturville High School in 1957, G. L. attended UT Martin. He was a founding member of the Fraternal Order of Phi Sigma Kappa, he was a TWRA commissioner from 1997-2003, serving as the chairman the last year of his term. He was a TN State Representative of the 88th General Assembly from 1973-1975, a long time member of the Decatur Co. Republican Party, and served on the Decatur Co. Republican Executive Committee. He was currently serving as the President of Teague Sand and Gravel, a position he has held since 1969. He also had served on the Decatur Co. Election Commission and the Decatur County School Board. G. L. was a member of Parsons First Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife of over 49 years, Mary Ella Wilkins Teague, a daughter, Felecia (Jason) Kobeck, a son, Mark (Ginger) Teague, all of Parsons, a brother, Dr. Paul F. (Barbara) Teague of Jackson, a sister, Judy Odle, of Lexington, 5 Grandchildren, Robert (Catherine) Hamilton, Rosemary Hamilton, Trevor, Tyler and Tanner Teague, and by 3 Great Grandchildren, Elise and Mary Houston Hamilton and Dellarose Ward.

Funeral services for Mr. Teague will be conducted from the sanctuary of

Parsons First Baptist Church on Saturday, April 23rd at 1 PM with Bro. LaVaughn Moody and Bro. Kevin Bromley officiating. Burial will follow in Bear Creek Cemetery in Parsons.

Serving as pallbearers will be Trevor, Tyler and Tanner Teague, Robert Hamilton, Barrett Rich and Todd Teague.
