James W. McKee, age 85, passed away on Saturday, September 2, 2023 in Lexington. He was a member of First Baptist Church in Lexington where he was a Deacon, and taught Sunday School for over 40 years. He was the Assistant County Agent in Haywood County for the UT Agricultural Extension Service and was later the Lead Agent for Henderson County. Later, he was the District Supervisor of West Tennessee for the UT Agricultural Extension service. He was involved in Haywood County 4-H and also was the EMA Director for Henderson County. He is survived by his wife, Beverly McKee; 2 daughters, Annette Fitzgerald (Jeff) and Delaine Bowman (Chris); 1 brother, Donald McKee (Connie); 1 sister in law, Ellen McKee; 7 grandchildren, Brian Jones (Anna), Brad Jones (Cary), Zack Fitzgerald (Laurel), Steven Bowman, Sarah Green (Zach), Jonathan Bowman (Moriah), and David Bowman (Emily); and 5 great grandchildren, Norah Jones, Hadley Jones, Luke Jones, Blair Jones, and Penelope Green. He was preceded in death by his parents, Dallas and Louise McKee; and 1 brother, Dallas Boyd McKee Jr. Funeral services will be on Tuesday, September 5 at 3PM at First Baptist Church in Lexington with burial to follow in Lexington Cemetery. 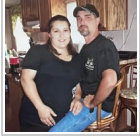
