Graveside Masonic Services will be held at Kelley Cemetery, Bath Springs, TN, at 2 PM on Sunday, April 9th.

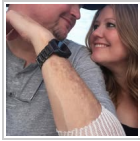
Visitation will be Saturday 1:30 PM - 10 PM and Sunday 10 AM - 1:30 PM at Reed's Chapel - Scotts Hill.
