Jerry Lee Renfroe of Lexington passed away on Friday, October 23, 2020 in Jackson after a brief battle with COVID-19. He was born September 22, 1951 to the late Covie Lee and Ernestine Wallace Renfroe. Jerry graduated from Lexington High School. He enlisted in the Tennessee Army National Guard where he served and retired in 2003. Jerry was an active supporter and team member of the Tennessee Baptist Disaster Relief as well as Beech River Baptist Association, where he served as Disaster Relief Director. Along with disaster relief, he served the community and county. Whether it was building wheelchair ramps for those in need or delivering food to the elderly, he enjoyed helping others. He will be remembered for his infectious smile and gentle spirit. Jerry leaves behind his wife of 49 years, Phyllis; two sons, Micah (Terri Jo) and Josh; three granddaughters, Carliee Jo, Gracie, and Audrey; two brothers, David (Kay) and Harold (Sherry) along with one nephew, three nieces, and one great nephew, and three great nieces. He was preceded in death by his parents and one brother, Kenneth Wayne Renfroe. The family has chosen cremation. A memorial service will be scheduled at a later date. 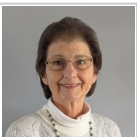
