



Jody Darrell Duke

March 4, 1951 - February 19, 2022

Mr. Jody Darrell Duke, age 70, of Murfreesboro, TN, was called to his eternal home in Glory on Saturday, February 19, 2022. Originally from Darden, TN, in Henderson County, Jody was born on March 4, 1951, to the late Ohlen and Lucille Lewis Duke.

Jody proudly served in the Tennessee National Guard for 6 years and later went on to graduate from Nashville Auto Diesel College. He married his wife Charlene Grissom Duke in 1977, and they had two children together, Joseph Duke and Chelsey Duke Sandman. Jody worked for Gould Century Electric and Johnson Controls in Lexington, TN, then he moved his family to Murfreesboro, TN in 1992, where he began his career with Nissan North America in the stamping department. He retired from Nissan in 2010 and began a new job at NHK Seating. A couple years ago, he transitioned into part-time work driving fleet vehicles with Ford of Murfreesboro. As a man who enjoyed good company and driving on the open road, this was one of his favorite jobs.
