Kenneth Wayne Reed, age 71, passed away on Tuesday, May 14, 2019 in Jackson. He was a retired principal in the Henderson County School System and retiree from Tennessee Army National Guard. He was a member, deacon, and Sunday school teacher at First Baptist Church and a member of the Gideons.
