Levie “Sue” Cannon Melton, a beloved wife, mother, and grandmother, age 92, was called to her eternal rest on Sunday, Oct. 5, 2025, at Henderson County Community Hospital. Born on Sept. 18, 1933, in Henderson County, her life journey was marked by devotion, resilience, and an unwavering commitment to faith, family and friends. She loved very deeply and strived sacrificially to help make life better for those she loved.

Having lost both her parents at the age of twelve, Sue lived with older siblings. She attended Sand Ridge Elementary School, Humes High School in Memphis, and Lexington High School.
