Lewis Clark Screws, Sr. age 81, passed away Saturday, July 1, 2023 in Lexington, Tenn. He was a native of Alabama and committed his life to serving Southern Baptist Churches in Alabama and Tennessee. He was also a popular Revival Speaker and Bible Study teacher in Alabama, Tennessee, Texas and Kentucky and led Mission trips to Pennsylvania and Arizona. 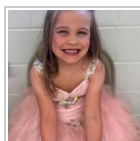

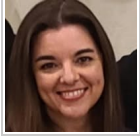
