



## Otis Duke

April 24, 1926 - January 26, 2018

Otis Austin Duke, age 91, of Darden, passed away on Friday, January 26, 2018 at his home surrounded by his loving family. Funeral services for Mr. Duke will be held on Sunday, January 28, 2018 at 2PM at Corinth Baptist Church with Bro. Don Franks officiating. Interment will follow in Mt. Ararat Cemetery. The family will receive friends on Saturday, January 27, 2018 from 5PM-9PM and on Sunday January 28, 2018 from 10AM until service. All visitation will be at Reed's Chapel in Lexington. Mr. Duke was born on April 24, 1926 to Luther and Beadie Autry Duke. He was Baptist by faith and a member of Corinth Baptist Church. After proudly serving his country as a United States Marine, Otis went on to receive his Bachelor's Degree in Education and became a teacher by profession. 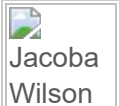
