From the family, it took a devoted and loving father, brother, uncle and cousin. From the community, it took a friend, hard worker, giving spirit, inspiration and joy. Richard Lynn Hall was born on April 13, 1949, to the Late David and Luella (Bell) Hall of McMoresville, TN. He professed a hope in Christ at an early age and joined the Cumberland Presbyterian Church in McMoresville, TN. Later in his life, he joined Broad Street Church of Christ in Lexington, TN. He attended public school in Carroll County, was a graduate of Trezevant High School and a graduate of Tyler Barber College – Memphis, TN, where he acquired a license as a professional barber. He was also a graduate of Jackson State Community College, with an Associate's Degree in Agriculture. Richard retired from the United States Army in 1989 after 20 years of honorable service.
