Robert Larry Graves, age 70, passed away on Wednesday, June 26, 2019 in Jackson. 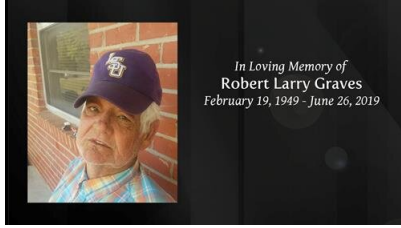

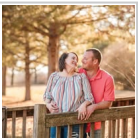
