Robert Hill Osborn, Sr., husband of the late Patricia Osborn, passed away peacefully on Tuesday May 5, 2020 at the TN State Veteran's Home in Humboldt, TN. Robert was born on November 21, 1929 in Fresno, CA to Frank and Ollie Mae Osborn. He was the youngest of five siblings and enjoyed his childhood growing up on a Standard Oil pump station in rural California. After graduating high school he joined the Navy and served during the Korean War, during which time he met and married his wife of over 64 years, Patricia, who was a Navy RN. He went on to get his Bachelor's Degree in Agricultural Engineering from Cal Poly University and was employed by the Soil Conservation Service until he retired. He enjoyed being outdoors, gardening, and working with his hands. He also enjoyed reading, studying his Bible, and was active in the churches he and his wife attended while their health permitted.

Robert and Patricia had four children: Tracey Coffman (Joseph), Terry Conrad (Charlie), Robert Osborn, Jr. (Dana), and the late Walter "Scott" Osborn. 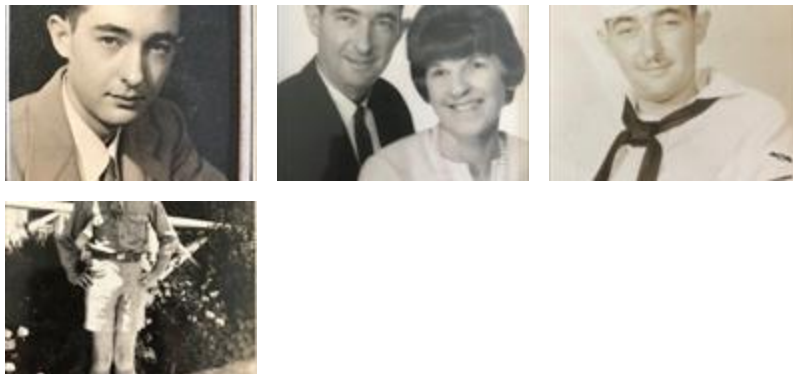
