Visitation will be Sunday 1 PM - 10 PM and Monday 9 AM until service.

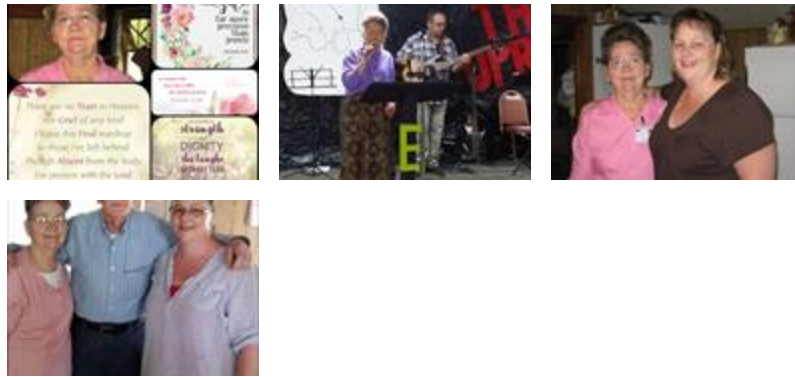
