



William David Blankenship Sr.

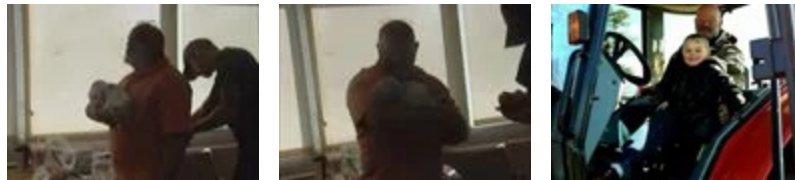
September 2, 1960 - April 9, 2021

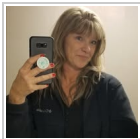
